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REGISTRATION & ENTRIES

- Register before the closing date. Only ONE entry per category.
- Cancellations: Full refund (minus R50 admin fee) before the deadline.
- No refunds after the registration deadline.
- Late entries subject to availability and fee.

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DIVISIONS / AGE GROUPS

UNDER 13 (U13)

Ages 12 & under

UNDER 18 (U18)

Ages 13 to 17

SENIOR / OPEN

Ages 18 to 49

MASTERS

Ages 50 & older

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EQUIPMENT & BOW CATEGORIES

OLYMPIC RECURVE

Standard recurve bows with sights, clickers, stabilizers.

BAREBOW

Recurve bows without sights or clickers.
Max arrow: 9.3mm.

TRADITIONAL

Recurve/Longbow shot off shelf. No elevated rests/plungers. No sights/stabilization.

HORSE BOW (HISTORICAL)

Asiatic/Magyar/Ottoman designs. No shelf, shot off hand/knuckle. No sights/stabilization.

All bows are subject to inspection.

Qualification Rounds

Three qualification sessions • 60 arrows per session • 2-minute ends

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QUALIFIER ROUND 1

ROUND FORMAT

Two 10-round shoots, with 3 arrows shot per round. You have 2 minutes to complete all 3 shots in each round.

TIME

9:00 am – 11:00 am

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QUALIFIER ROUND 2

ROUND FORMAT

Two 10-round shoots, with 3 arrows shot per round. You have 2 minutes to complete all 3 shots in each round.

TIME

11:00 am – 1:00 pm

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QUALIFIER ROUND 3

ROUND FORMAT

Two 10-round shoots, with 3 arrows shot per round. You have 2 minutes to complete all 3 shots in each round.

TIME

2:00 pm – 4:00 pm

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QUALIFICATION SCORING SUMMARY

ARROWS

60 per session.

ROUNDS

20 per session.

MAX SCORE

600 points.

Eliminations

Lancaster Shoot-Up • Step-ladder head-to-head format

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ELIMINATION FORMAT — THE LANCASTER SHOOT-UP

THE LADDER CLIMB

The two lowest-ranked finalists step up first. The winner moves up the ladder to face the next highest seed. The loser is eliminated.

12-ARROW SHOOTOUT

Each match consists of 12 arrows: 4 ends of 3 arrows. Each 3-arrow end has a 2-minute time limit.

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HIGHEST SCORE WINS

CUMULATIVE SCORING

There are no sets. The archer with the highest cumulative total score, out of a possible 120 points, wins the match and advances.

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THE ULTIMATE SHOWDOWN

PATH TO THE FINAL

The survivor who climbs the entire ladder earns the right to face the #1 overall qualifier in the final match for the championship title.

Finals

The Title Showdown • 12 arrows • 20 seconds per arrow

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THE FINALS FORMAT — THE TITLE SHOWDOWN

FINALS TIME LIMIT

20 SECONDS
PER ARROW

FINALS ONLY

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THE KING OF THE HILL MATCH

The lone surviving archer from the elimination bracket faces the tournament's #1 overall seed.

Both finalists shoot a total of 12 arrows: 4 ends of 3 arrows.

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12 ARROWS FOR THE GLORY

CUMULATIVE SCORING

No sets or resets. Every point is added to the running total.

MAXIMUM

Highest possible score: 120 points.

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SUDDEN-DEATH TIE BREAKER

SINGLE-ARROW SHOOT-OFF

If the scores are tied after 12 arrows, each archer shoots one arrow. The arrow closest to the absolute centre of the target wins the title.

Conduct & Safety

Range behaviour, official instructions and safety requirements

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CODE OF CONDUCT

- Respect fellow archers, judges, and spectators.
- Follow DOS and judge instructions instantly.
- Maintain absolute silence on the line while others are aiming.
- NO active mobile phones or text messaging on the line.
- NO headphones or wireless earbuds allowed on the line.
- Violations: Initial warning, followed by disqualification.

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SAFETY ON THE RANGE

- Only draw your bow on the shooting line and pointing at the targets.
- Wait explicitly for the whistle signal before crossing the line to retrieve arrows.
- Running on the archery range is strictly forbidden.
- High-draw (sky-drawing) above safety catch netting will result in immediate removal.

RANGE PRIORITY

Safety instructions and official range commands take priority during all stages of the competition.

Appeals & Awards

Formal protests, committee decisions and championship recognition

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APPEALS & FORMAL PROTESTS

- Appeals regarding rule interpretations or formal protests must be submitted within 15 minutes of the incident.
- A protest fee of R200 must accompany the appeal.
- The protest fee is refunded if committee rules in your favor.
